Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.32(7) Requires That Children Be Supervised at All Times Appropriate to the Individual Age, Needs and Capabilities of Each Child. Such Supervision Must Include, but Not Be Limited To, Indoor and Outdoor Activities, Mealtime, Naptime, Transportation, Field Trips, and Transitions Between Activities. "Supervision" Means That the Appropriate Number of Staff Members Are Physically Present in Th (2), 591-1-1-.19(2) Allows a Center to Designate Two Specific One Hour Periods Each Day When Only 25 Square Feet of Space per Child Is Provided for Children Three Years of Age and Older in Their Assigned Rooms or Areas. This Provision Is Intended to Account for Increased Attendance for Before-school and After-school Care. It Was Determined That There Were 16 Children in Room A Which Was Licensed for 12 (1), and 91-1-1-.33(5) Requires That Every Calendar Year After the First Year of Employment, All Supervisory and Caregiver Personnel, Except Independent Contractors, Students-in-Training and Volunteers Shall Attend Ten (10) Clock Hours of Diverse Training Which Is Task-focused in On-going Health, Safety and Early Childhood or Child Development Related Topics and Which Is Offered by an Accredited College, U (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.
