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1. Basic Overview

Kayla is a category B provider who has been registered since 2021. Prior to that she was non-registered with a Child Care Provider Agreement. Kayla does not participate in the food program but still provides the children with balanced and nutritious meals and snacks. There is a large fenced in back yard for the children to play in.

2. Identify Observed Strengths Of The Program

Kayla maintains a clean, organized home setting. There are no safety hazards in the home. Kayla interacts positively with the children and provides a nurturing environment. Kayla provides age-appropriate toys and activities for the children.

3. Identify The Aspects That Fall Below The Standard

Within six months of becoming registered, children 18 years of age or younger residing in the household must have: Admission physical exam report. Immunization certificate. For school age: Documentation of physical exam completed at time of school enrollment or since that time.

One of Kayla's children needs an updated physical examination in their file.

110.9 (4) c : A signed medical consent from the parent authorizing emergency treatment.

For school-aged children: On the first day of attendance, a statement of health status signed by the parent or legal guardian or admission physical examination that is not more than 12 months from the child's first day.

For school aged children: An annual statement of health condition signed by the parent or legal guardian, annually from date of statement of health or admission physical.

110.9 (4) f : For each school-age child, record of a physical exam completed at the time of school enrollment or since.

110.9 (4) g : A signed and dated immunization certificate provided by the state Department of Public Health.

110.9 (4) i : Documentation signed by the parent which names persons authorized to pick up the child, their telephone number, and relationship to the child.

110.9 (4) j : Written permission from the parent(s) for their child to attend activities away from the child development home.

Several of the children's files need updated documents.
