**1. Basic Overview**

Tracee Crusan has been a registered Child Development Home Provider since December of 2014. Tracee is a "C1" category Child Development Home Provider. This allows Tracee to have 8 preschool and school aged children at one time. Tracee currently has an approved Exception to Policy to allow her to have 9 children at one time. Tracee does not provide transportation for families in her care. There is one pet dog in the home. Tracee has 2 approved substitutes for her program. Tracee's hours of operation are 7am to 5pm Monday through Friday. Tracee's renewal time is in January of 2027. Tracee accepts all ages of children in her program.

**2. Identify Observed Strengths Of The Program**

Tracee has been a registered Child Development Home Provider for over ten years. Tracee provides care in the downstairs part of the home, with an egress with stairs as a second exit. The basement area is dedicated completely to childcare. It is populated with multiple learning posters, children's furniture, and many objects which encourage learning, exploration, and large-small motor development. There is a kitchen area to provide meals and snacks. Tracee provides structure for the children with story time, group dancing, and other group activities. The children also have free play. Tracee uses Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports and Positive Parenting for behavior management. Corporal punishment is not practiced in the Child Development Home. Tracee has completed Safe Sleep training and when she has children 12 months or younger the policy is practiced. Children in Tracee's care receive regular meals and snacks as appropriate. Tracee's required postings are functional. Tracee's child files and provider files are very organized and easily accessible.
