1. Basic Overview

I conducted a compliance visit with Registered Child Development Home Category B provider Rebecca Scheidel on 11/3/2025. Rebecca has been involved with child care for 20 years. Rebecca continues providing care in an out-building not attached to her house that is completely designated for child care only. The building has no stairs and includes heated floors. She had 5 children in care during the time of our visit. Rebecca stays within her Category B provider numbers through the balance of several part-time children. Rebecca has no HHS-approved substitutes or assistants. She recently renewed her certification in September of 2025 and is good through 8/31/2027.

2. Identify Observed Strengths Of The Program

Rebecca's child care design is very open and clutter free with lots of space for the children. Rebecca can see almost all of the child care space wherever she is. The children have regular outside time in her fenced in back yard. Rebecca describes her curriculum as mostly faith-based learning activities mixed with free play, arts, coloring, and puzzles. Rebecca currently has a very young group of children during most of the day and her activities are selected to accommodate this. She demonstrated good control of her environment and was attentive to the children.
