1. Basic Overview

Kristin Current has been a registered Child Development Home Provider since August of 2024. Currently Kristin is a category "B" CDH Provider. Kristin accepts all ages of children in her Child Development Home. Kristine does provide transportation for the families in her care including field trips and school pick-up. There is one pet dog in the Child Development Home. Kristin does not have any Substitutes or Assistants at this time. Kristin's hours of availability for care are Monday through Friday 7am to 5pm. Kristin's renewal time is in July of 2026, she should receive a renewal packet from the Registration Unit in June of 2026.

2. Identify Observed Strengths Of The Program

Kristin has earned a bachelor's degree in early childhood education. Kristin identifies structure, routine, and management as



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strengths in her Child Development Home. Kristin takes the children in her care on frequent outings and field trips. Kristin's main care area is in the basement of the CDH with a walkout door. The area downstairs is furnished with child appropriate furniture and large and small motor equipment and objects. The walkout door goes to the outside area where there are playground equipment and activities for the children to interact with when weather permits. The downstairs area is also equipped with a kitchen which allows her to provide meals and snacks in the care area. Kristin identified she effectively communicates with families on Bright Wheels. Kristin has completed Safe Sleep training; the practice is implemented when she has children 12 months or younger. Kristin uses "Break Away Time" and redirection as behavioral interventions. Corporal punishment is not practiced in the Child Development Home. Kristin participates with the Food Program, the children in her care receive regular meals and snacks as appropriate. Kristin's required paperwork postings are appropriately posted throughout the care area. Kristin's required files and paperwork are complete, organized, and easily accessible.

3. Identify The Aspects That Fall Below The Standard

110.8 (1) c : Combustible materials are kept away from furnaces, stoves, gas dryers, or water heaters by a minimum of three feet.

All dogs and cats have annual examinations. Records of the exams are on file and must verify that routine immunizations are current and animal is free of endo and ecto parasites.

Form 470-5153, Pet Health Examination Veterinary Health Certificate, is on file.

1. All materials need to be moved 3 feet away from the water heater and furnace.
2. DHHS Pet Vet Forms need to be completed each year. You communicated you are waiting for the Vet to process the fecal tests and then they will complete the form for this year.
