Justina's husband, Nathan, is approved as her assistant and substitute and her two daughters, Alora and Haily are approved assistants. Justina recently earned her AA degree and is currently working on her BA. Justina also participates in IQ4K.

2. Identify Observed Strengths Of The Program

Justina has an abundance of educational and sensory toys for the children to enjoy. During the compliance visit children were observed to be looking at bugs under a magnifying glass, playing with a wind tunnel and playing with building blocks. Justina has a garden and a mud kitchen outside for the children to experience, as well as a butterfly habitat and indoor fish tanks with snails and fish. Justina was observed following safe sleep practices with an infant. Justina was also observed comforting a crying child and assisting a child who had wet their pants. Justina was kind and affectionate with her interactions.
