1. Basic Overview

I conducted a compliance check with Registered Child Development Home Category B provider Ashley Schuchhardt on 8/22/2025. Ashley renewed her registration in March 2025 and changed from a Category A to a Category B provider. Ashley continues using primarily the main floor, with some use of a large play room in the basement. Ashley has an egress window in the basement, and will just need to add a step system as a Category B provider. Ashley had 7 children in care during the time of my visit. Ashley and her husband are adding a full privacy fence to their open back yard. Ashley has one HHS-approved substitute/assistant. She has been doing child care for 3 years.

2. Identify Observed Strengths Of The Program

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Ashley offers a mix of structured and free play with her children. She works in learning activities with her schedule depending on the ages of the children. Ashley and the children have regular outside time, with most of their play at a local park. Ashley is on the Food Program. The children had spaces on the main floor and the basement that were primarily designated for her child care operation. She had children ranging from school-age down to infants during my visit.

3. Identify The Aspects That Fall Below The Standard

110.9 (1) a : Within six months of becoming registered, a physical exam report documented on form 470-5152, Child Care Provider Physical Examination Report, for all household members over the age of 18. Physical exams should be repeated every three years.

- Ashley needs to obtain a current physician signed statement of health for herself to have on file. This needs to be completed using the State form she has a copy of and needs to be renewed every 3 years.

The bottom of the window opening is not more than 44 inches above the floor with permanent steps inside leading up to the window.

- Ashley recently changed from Category A to Category B. She does sometimes use a large play room in her basement level with a low egress window. As a Category B provider, Ashley will need to add a permanent step system to the egress window. The window is low enough, a two or three step system will suffice to allow access to the window by a child. She can send me a picture of the step system by email or text.

Ashley needs to install the step system to her egress window and send me a picture by 11/14/2025. Her health statement should be on file by 10/31/2025 and will be reviewed during her next visit.
