Amber Durand has been a childcare provider for over 15 years in the Council Bluffs area. She currently has a full roster at 12 children. While visiting today she had 8 preschool aged children. Her hours are cover most of the daytime 6 am to 5 pm. The provider reported that she would like to work on IQ4K qualifications to become rated. She reported that she will be working with Brightwheel soon. She has recently been working to get this program set up for her childcare. The provider's files were all up to date and organized.

2. Identify Observed Strengths Of The Program

While at the home, compliance staff was able to observe the provider with the children. She had asked them to do a quick pick up to move on to the next thing. Once the children were ready, she told them to go grab a busy box. Compliance staff was intrigued by the busy box idea. There is a cart with drawers. Each drawer has a different activity. One was bis numbers that looked like race tracks, can follow the number with miniature cars. One was kinetic sand with tools to move it around. One had smaller magnet cubes in them to build whatever the child was interested in. I thought this was a neat idea.

The provider was available to all the children in care. She talked to them and answered questions and needs. A child had an accident and she helped that child out to the restroom and then cleaned up the mess. The provider went about her day like nothing had happened. The provider was responsive to the two infants in care as well. We discussed safe sleep and how the provider maintains safety for the little ones. With the information compliance staff shared, the provider talked about updating her policy.
