1. Basic Overview

I completed a compliance visit with Registered Child Development Home Category C1 provider Jami McMurray 1/6/2026. Jami has been involved in child care for 8 years. Jami continues using the main floor only of her 2 story home. Jami has no HHS-approved substitutes, and has one HHS-approved assistant who is present during most of the day. Jami uses her open side and back yard as an outside play area. She has 5 dogs and 2 cats, all with current vet statements on file. Jami had 2 children in care during the time of our visit, and currently has a total of 8 children enrolled with several being part time. Jami is due for a renewal in July 2026.

2. Identify Observed Strengths Of The Program

Jami is currently working on becoming IQ4K certified and has very regular contact with her CCR&R worker. She uses the Brightwheel application for most of her paperwork, billing, and files. Jami uses an on-line curriculum for ideas and mixes free play with multiple child led activities including reading, coloring, music, and other structured activities. Jami is very accommodating with her parents, and is willing to watch kids into an evening shift when requested. She keeps her numbers low during significant periods of the day which allows for good attention to the children. Jami participates with the Food Program to enhance the nutrition of her snacks and meals.
