I conducted a compliance visit with Registered Child Development Home Category A provider Alaina Goodvin on 5/19/2026. Alaina has been involved in child care for 2 years. She continues using the main floor only of her ranch style home. They are remodeling portions of the basement and she may consider future use of that level. Alaina had 5 countable children present during our visit. The entire main floor is used for child care which gives her good space for the children and bedroom options for napping. Alaina has one pet dog and has a current vet statement on file. She has a fenced back yard for her outside play area. Alaina is due to renew her registration effective 9/30/2026 and is hoping to renew as a Category B provider giving her more options for numbers of children in care. Alaina has no HHS-approved substitutes or assistants at this time.

2. Identify Observed Strengths Of The Program

Alaina has an excellent background with a degree in education and years of teaching before transitioning to child care. She is currently using the Brightwheel computer application with her operation. Alaina describes her strengths as understanding the developmental stages of the children and her ability to plan age appropriate activities. She has a very young group right now so her curriculum is pretty simple. Alaina uses sensory tables, a trip once a week to the library, and lots of free play. She displayed good multitasking skills during our visit being able to get things for me while also paying close attention the children.
