CHILD CARE ANNUAL EVALUATION

1. Basic Overview

Gina has been providing child care services since approximately 2014 and has been registered with the state of Iowa for the majority of that time. Gina accepts children aged infant through school age and is available for care Monday-Friday for first shift care. Gina reports that she does not provide a 'structured' routine for the kids, but rather an environment that encourages imaginative play. Gina stresses the importance of allowing kids to be kids and learn social skills through normal play interactions.

2. Identify Observed Strengths Of The Program

Gina believes her greatest strength in working with children is her realization and understanding that kids really do need to 'just be kids'. Gina believes there is too much importance and emphasis placed on learning, education and structure early on in a child's life. Gina wants kids to feel like kids, rest and play since they have a long road ahead of them that includes education and structured learning. Gina is a participant in the CACFP food program for child care providers. Gina has a large variety of toys available to children in her care, including varied ages and stages of development.

3. Identify The Aspects That Fall Below The Standard

All dogs and cats have annual examinations. Records of the exams are on file and must verify that routine immunizations are current and animal is free of endo and ecto parasites.

Form 470-5153, Pet Health Examination Veterinary Health Certificate, is on file.

Gina has three dogs and 1 cat. All of them had exams in April 2025 and are due again. They are all scheduled for next week.

Gina did not have her current certificate of registration. This worker will mail and/or email certificate to Gina.

Gina's husband Travis needs updated physical documented on required HHS form. Prior physical was 9/26/2022.

Gina needs to update enrollment forms for all enrolled children (sign and date again). Gina needs to ensure all children have updated physicals and immunizations as a few of the reviewed files were more than one year old.
