**1. Basic Overview**

Savanna provides child care to children aged infant through school age. Savanna offers child care for all three shifts of care. Savanna reported that she provides options to kids in her care in terms of activities and things to do.

**2. Identify Observed Strengths Of The Program**

Savanna believes her greatest strength in working with children is that they see her "as a pal". Savanna reported that she understands their needs and enjoys spending time with them. Savanna reported that she communicates well with both the children and their parents. Savanna believes that it 'takes a village' when working with children.

**3. Identify The Aspects That Fall Below The Standard**

110.8 (1) h : Has a minimum of one single-station, battery-operated, UL-approved smoke detector in each child-occupied room and at the top of every stairway.

110.8 (3) a : All medicines and poisonous, toxic, or otherwise unsafe materials are secured from access by a child.

The first-aid kit shall, at a minimum, include adhesive bandages, bottled water, disposable tweezers, and disposable plastic gloves.

Fire and tornado drills are practiced monthly and documentation kept on file for the current year and previous year.

110.9 (4) c : A signed medical consent from the parent authorizing emergency treatment.

**4. Any corrective action plans, provisional license, and safety plans-steps to get into compliance**

Savanna had two smoke detectors that were not installed upon arrival. This worker assisted putting the detectors back up as Savanna was unable to due to an injury to her elbow causing her to wear a sling. Nothing further needed for smoke detectors.

Savanna needs to either move items under the bathroom and kitchen sinks so they are inaccessible to children or child locks need to be placed on these doors.

Savanna has a first aid kit, however, needs gloves and a bottle of water added to it.

Savanna has started 2026 drills and documentation, however, 2025 drill records were not in her binder. Other years were present, but 2025 was missing.

Several child files did not have the required emergency medical treatment authorization form. Savanna needs to ensure all files have this form.

Savanna's Mandatory Child Abuse Reporter training appears to be expired. Savanna needs to update this training.

There were concerns that Savanna's mother was residing in the home and was not an approved household member. A safety plan was completed with Savanna on 1/15/26 stating that all household members, assistants and substitutes must be prior approved by the CCA Unit. Savanna stated that her mother would no longer be spending the night with her effective immediately.

**5. Special Notes/recommendations**

Targeted Compliance: Emergency Preparedness Plan

Savanna's Emergency Preparedness Plan was thoroughly reviewed for accuracy. Savanna added an out of area evacuation location as this was not included in the original EPP.

Savanna will need an updated physical by July 2026.

Savanna's MART training looks to be expired. Savanna needs to update her MART training.
