● 5 Important

Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were One Child's Physical Did Not Have a Signature. (1), One Side of the Fence Surrounding the Outdoor Play Area Was Not Properly Secured. (1), and Verification of Current CPR Training Is Needed for the Licensee. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **Verification of a Current TB Test Is Needed for the Licensee.**

The caregiver shall maintain and make available verification of the following: A

● **There Was a Ladder Accessible in Outdoor Fenced in Play Area.**

The licensee shall ensure that no conditions exist in the home or on the grounds

● **Verification of Current CPR Training Is Needed for the Licensee.**
