Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Verification of Current CPR Training Is Needed for the Licensee and One Caregiver. (1), During the Visit There Was Not Any Verification of Current CPR on File for the Caregiver That Was Present. (1), and During the Visit Thirteen Kids of Mixed Ages Were Present with One Caregiver. An Additional Caregiver Is Required. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
