Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 12 Children Were Outside on Playground Area Without an Adult. 2 Staff Were in Back Room with Door Closed. 2 Staff Were in Living Room, One on Couch and One Caring for an Infant and Talking with Another Parent. Glass Sliding Door Was Closed. (3) and During the Visit, One Caregiver Was Present with One Child Under 16 Months and 10 Children Over 16 Months. (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.
