Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Program Self-reported That a Child Was in the Wrong Room and Not Supervised for a Short Period of Time (2), Program Self Reported That a Caregiver Did Not Follow the Infant's Individual Feeding Schedule by Providing Them Formula That Wasn't Part of Their Scheduled Meal. (1), and Program Self Reported That a Caregiver Did Not Follow the Infant's Individual Feeding Plan by Providing Them Formula That Was Not Their Own. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
