● 3 Important

Across 2 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were Child Under 24 Months on a Cot. Children Under 24 Months Must Be in a Crib, Portacrib, or Playpen Until Variance Approval Letter Is Received. (1), There Was a Complaint of Animal Sanitation. The Home Does Have a Smell of Animal Excrement. No Animal Excrement Was Seen in the Childcare Areas. Litter Boxes Are Behind 2 Locked Doors. (1), and The Small Fence in the Frontyard Was Confirmed to Have Been Used. This Small White Fence Cannot Be Used as an Approved "Fenced in Area". (1). None of the 3 findings were critical.

The licensee shall ensure that no conditions exist in the home or on the grounds

● The Small Fence in the Frontyard Was Confirmed to Have Been Used. This Small White Fence Cannot Be Used as an Approved "Fenced in Area".

The licensee shall provide a protected outdoor play area that is safely enclosed
