There Are Toys and Clothes on the Cabinets in the Bathroom Which Are Not Sanitizable. In the Bears, the Vaccum Is Being Stored in the Bathroom Which Is Not Sanitizable. (1), Due to Incident on 5.5.25, Caregiver Used Inappropriate Discipline to Correct a Child. (1), and In the Two Year Old Classrooms, Changing Tables Were Not Sanitized. (1).
