## 2 Inspection Visits Since 2023 - 5 Findings

Most recent inspection: Oct 18, 2024

● 5 Important

Across 2 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were Upon Arrival One Caregiver Was Present with 13 Kids Who Were Three Years of Age and Older. The Child to Staff Ratio Should Have Been 13:2. During the Visit a Second Caregiver Arrived. (1), Two Kids Did Not Have Proof of Date of Birth in the File. (1), and A Current TB Test Is Needed for One Caregiver. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
