Across 1 inspection since 2026, the issues cited most often were Observed Children's Tylenol, Acetaminophen, and Orajel Accessible in an Unlocked Cabinet in Classroom 3. (1), Observed Children Not Washing Their Hands After a Diaper Change in the Toddler Room. (1), and Observed Sunscreen, Odorban, Dawn Dishsoap, Hand Sanitizer, Toothpaste, Teacher's Prescription Medicine, and Adult Tylenol Accessible in an Unlocked Cabinet in Room 3. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
