Across 1 inspection since 2026, the issues cited most often were A Riding Lawn Mower Was Accessible in the Outdoor Fenced in Play Area. (1), On 4/9/2026 the Daycare Did Not Have the Proper Number of Qualified Caregiver Directly Caring for the Number of Children While They Were Outside Playing in the Fenced in Play Area. Children Are Considered Unsupervised Without a Qualified Caregiver Present. (1), and The Licensee and Two Caregivers Did Not Have Current Universal Precautions Training. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

- **On 4/9/2026 the Daycare Did Not Have the Proper Number of Qualified Caregiver Directly Caring for the Number of Children While They Were Outside Playing in the Fenced in Play Area. Children Are Considered Unsupervised Without a Qualified Caregiver Present.**

Children shall not be left unattended and shall be supervised at all times

- **On 4/9/2026 the Daycare Did Not Have the Proper Number of Qualified Caregivers Directly Caring for the Kids That Were in Attendance. They Had One Qualified Caregiver with Fifteen Kids of Mixed Ages and the Required Ratio for That Age Group Is 15:2.**

The following child to staff ratios apply: Type of Home Child:Staff Ratio Infant

- **A Riding Lawn Mower Was Accessible in the Outdoor Fenced in Play Area.**

The licensee shall ensure that no conditions exist in the home or on the grounds

- **The Licensee and Two Caregivers Did Not Have Current Universal Precautions Training.**

The licensee shall maintain the following documentation in the child care home f

- **Two Kids Did Not Have a Physical.**

Within thirty (30) days of a childs admission, the licensee shall receive a writ
