Across 2 inspections since 2026, the issues cited most often were Arrived at the Childcare Home Staff Present Does Not Have Documentation of a Physical to Verify That the Current State Requirements Has Been Met. (2), Fence Has Missing Planks and Exposed Nails Within Reach of Children. (1), and Staff JA Present Does Not Have Documentation of a CPR and First Aid to Verify That the Current State Requirements Has Been Met. Staff AM Has Expired CPR and First Aid. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
