Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were On 9/12 the Children Were Left Unsupervised by Employees. (1), The Home Has an Unqualified Staff Member on Site. The Employee Does Not Have a File or Current Physical. (1), and The Home Is Out of Ratio Due to an Unqualified Staff Member Present. The Ratio Is 1:10 (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
