Across 1 inspection since 2025, the issues cited most often were No One at the Home Daycare Had Current CPR First Aid (1), The Provider Did Not Have Current Consents for Background Checks to Be Conducted. (1), and The Provider Did Not Have a Current Consent Where Protective Services and Sex Offender Checks Were Conducted. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

An applicant must submit the necessary information, forms, or consents for the d
- **No One at the Home Daycare Had Current CPR First Aid**  
At least one (1) direct child care provider shall be trained in pediatric cardio
- **The Provider Had Garbage Can but the Lid Had Braoken and Had Not Been Replaced**  
Caregiver shall keep garbage in containers with tight-fitting lids and remove it
- **The Provider Had a Bleach Spray Cleaner Under the Kitchen Sink That Did Not Have a Key Lock in Place and Was Where the Children Could Reach the Cleaner.**  
Caregiver shall keep poisonous or hazardous materials that would harm children,
- **The Provider Did Not Have a Current Consent Where Protective Services and Sex Offender Checks Were Conducted.**
