Two Personal Bedrooms and a Medicine Cabinet Unlocked, with Personal Hygiene Items, Cleaners, and Medicine Within Reach. (1), and One New Staff Member Needs a Consent Form. This Staff Has a Fingerprints Reciept. However, This Is Not Valid Without a Consent Form. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
