Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Items That State Keep Out of Reach of Children Accessible to Children in the Storage Room, Near Diaper Changing Station and by Garage Door at Time of Visit. (1), Storage Room Has Only 1 Means of Escape at Time of Visit. (1), and Wood Panels, Broken Screen, Recliner, Etc. on Premises at Time of Visit. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

Caregiver shall not permit trash, flammable, and combustible materials, includin

● **Storage Room Has Only 1 Means of Escape at Time of Visit.**

Each room of the home where child care services are provided is required to have

● **TB Test Results Expired for 4 Caregivers at Time of Visit. *Send Documentation.**

The caregiver shall maintain and make available verification of the following: A

● **Immunizations Missing for 4 Children Present at Time of Visit. *Send Documentation.**

Within thirty (30) days of a childs admission, the licensee shall receive a writ
