Across 1 inspection since 2025, the issues cited most often were The Provider Has a First Aid Kit with Only Band Aids and a Few Wipes Inside. (1), The Back Bedroom Does Not Have the Outlet Coverings in Place. (1), and The Provider Has a Shed in the Back Yard That Has the Door Off the Hinges That Allows Access to the Insder Where There Are Tools That Are Powered and Supplies That Children Should Not Have Access To. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
