(3), Two Cribs in Infant Room with Loose Screws (1), and Each Childcare Provider, Household Member, Employee, Volunteer Caregiver Shall Submit Fingerprints for a National Criminal History Background Check by the FBI or Each Childcare Provider Has Local Criminal Check with Documentation That National Check Is Applied For. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
