Across 1 inspection since 2025, the issues cited most often were At Time of Visit, One Child File Out of Ten Had No Documentation of a Physician, and Ten Out of Ten Had No Address on File for Physician, and Seven Out of Ten Had No Dentist on File. (2), At Time of Visit Three Out of Ten Staff Files Did Not Have Documentation of Child Abuse and Neglect Training. (1), and Items Labeled 'Keep Out of Reach of Children' Accessible as Follows: Unlocked Storage Room Had Shaving Cream and a Teacher Bag. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

All caregivers and other persons counted in child/staff ratios shall have training

● **At Time of Visit Three Out of Ten Staff Files Did Not Have Documentation of Child Abuse and Neglect Training.**

During the first two (2) weeks of employment, all staff shall receive documented

● **Items Labeled 'Keep Out of Reach of Children' Accessible as Follows: Unlocked Storage Room Had Shaving Cream and a Teacher Bag.**
