Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were One Staff Member Did Not Wash Hands After Changing the Diaper of One Child Prior to Touching Toys in the Classroom. (1), One 2 Year Old Did Not Wash Hands After Their Diaper Was Changed. (1), and The Bathroom by the Pre-K Room Has Hand Soap Labeled Keep Out of Reach of Children with in Reach on the Sink. The One Year Old Room Has Hand Soap Labeled Keep Out of Reach of Children Within Reach on the Sink in the Bathroom. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

- **One 2 Year Old Did Not Wash Hands After Their Diaper Was Changed.**
