Across 1 inspection since 2025, the issues cited most often were The Provider Needs a Smoke Detector at the Top of the Stairs of the Basement. (1), The Provider and Staff Did Not Have Current TB (1), and The Provider Had the Faucet in the Bathroom Had Plastic Covering and Was Not Working (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

- **There Was a Bottle of Degrease Cleanser in the Bathroom That Was in Reach of the Children. It Was Removed During the Insepection**
Caregiver shall keep poisonous or hazardous materials that would harm children,
- **The Provider Had a Bucket of Soapy Cleaning Water That Was Sitting in the Bathtub but Was in Access of the Children. The Bucket Was Emptied and Moved During the Insepection.**
Caregiver shall store implements and tools, including, but not limited to: power
- **The Provider Needs a Smoke Detector at the Top of the Stairs of the Basement.**
Licensee shall provide electrical or battery-operated smoke detector that is ins
- **The Provider and Staff Did Not Have Current TB**
The caregiver shall maintain and make available verification of the following: A
- **The Provider Had the Faucet in the Bathroom Had Plastic Covering and Was Not Working**
The licensee shall ensure that no conditions exist in the home or on the grounds
