Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were The Provider Had a Fireextinguisher in the Kitchen That Was Expired in 2024 and Was on Empty. (2), The Provider Had 2 Staff at the Daycare with No CPR/FA Training. (1), and The Provider Had 2 Dirty Diapers on the Top of the Changing Tables That Had Not Been Disposed Of. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
