Across 2 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were Items Labeled "Keep Out of Reach of Children" Were Accessible to the Children. (2), Garden tools(Clipping Shears in the Front Entry of the Home)need to Be Locked and Out of the Children's Reach. (1), and Three Staff with Expired TB Documentation. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
