Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were On 9/30/25 a 3 Year Old Child Was Without Supervision of a Caregiver When He Went Into a Classroom From the Hallway and the Teacher Did Not Notice. (2), Efficient Supervision Was Not Followed During the Transition of Parents Picking Up and Moving From Classroom to Classroom, Threshold Count Was Not Completed Between Caregivers. (1), and Provider Has Not Cooperated with the Division by Returning All Requested Documentation for the Previous Plan of Improvement Within 30 Days of the Inspection on 5/29/25. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
