Across 1 inspection since 2026, the issues cited most often were One Kid Did Not Have a Suspension and Expulsion Policy in the File. (1), During the Visit Eleven Kids of Mixed Ages Were Present with One Caregiver. The Child to Staff Ratio Should Be 11:2. A Second Caregiver Is Required. (1), and One Kid Did Not Have Current Immunization Records in the File. (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.
