All Children's Files Must Be Available to the Division Upon Request. (1), and For a Microfacility, the Group Size Is Determined by the Average Age of the Group. At the Time of Visit, the Average Age Was 11.7 Months; Therefore, the Group Size Should Be 8 Children Max. During the Visit, 9 Children Were in Attendance. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
