Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Items Labeled Keep Out of the Reach of Children Were Accessible to Children (Cleaning Supplies in Kitchen, Bathroom) (2), Closet Door in Hallway Not Secured/off Hinges. (1), and Home Missing One Fire Extinguisher. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
