Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were The Provider Had Dish Soap Under the Sink that Was Not Secured. The Items Were Moved and Placed Out of the Reach During the Inspection. (2), The Gate to the Outside Play Area Has Very Tall and Large Weeds Growing That Block the Entrance. The Grass Is High and Needs to Be Mowed. The Staff Stated the Children Have Not Been Outside Recently but We Have Had Good Weather. (1), and The Provider Had a Staff Member KW Did Not Have a Current Consent. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
