Across 1 inspection since 2026, the issues cited most often were During the Visit There Was Not a Caregiver Present with Verification of Current CPR Training. (1), There Was Not Any Verification of Fire Drills on File. (1), and One Caregiver Did Not Have a Physical on File. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

A child care home shall, at no expense to the state, maintain and make available

● **During the Visit There Was Not a Caregiver Present with Verification of Current CPR Training.**

At least one(1) adult individual who maintains current certification in a course

● **One Caregiver Did Not Have a Physical on File.**

Direct child care providers who work in the home more than three (3) times a mon

● **There Was Not Any Verification of Fire Drills on File.**

The caregiver shall conduct and document quarterly fire drills

● **The Cover of a Floor Vent in One of the Rooms Used for Childcare Was Not Properly Secured. There Was Damage Observed in the Bathroom Ceiling.**

The licensee shall ensure that no conditions exist in the home or on the grounds
