Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were The Provider Did Not Have Shot Records for AR and ACR and the Child Had Started Over a Month Ago. (2), There Is a HM That Lives in the Home Now That Has Not Completed a Consent. The HM Does Have FP (1), and There Is a HM That Is in the Home Now That Did Not Have a TB (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

- **There Is a HM That Lives in the Home Now That Has Not Completed a Consent. The HM Does Have FP**
