Across 1 inspection since 2024, the issues cited most often were During File Review, on Staff File Was Missing Documentation of Current First Aid Training. (1), Some Items Labeled "Keep Out of Reach of Children" Were Accessible to Children. The Janitor's Closet Was Unlocked with Several Cans of Wall Paint on Low Open Shelving. The Teacher Workroom Was Unlocked and Had Hand Sanitizer on Low Open Desks. In the Monkey Room, Diaper Cream Was in a Low Unlocked (1), and During File Review, One Staff File Was Missing Documentation of a Physical Examination Signed by a Physician or Nurse Practitioner. (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.
