Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Provider Does Not Have Documentation of a Criminal History Check for One Provider. (1), No Drug Screen Results for Two Providers in Home. (1), and The Living Area of the Home Is Not Made Inaccessible to Children Therefore Rooms Had Lotions, Soaps, Hairspray, Deodorants, and Febreze Accesible to Children. (1).
