Across 2 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were One Kid Did Not Have Immunization Records in the File. (2), Items Labeled Keep Out of Reach of Kids Were Accessible Under the Kitchen Sink. (1), and A Lawn Mower and Tools Were Accessible in the Outdoor Fenced in Play Area. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **A Lawn Mower and Tools Were Accessible in the Outdoor Fenced in Play Area.**

The licensee shall ensure that no conditions exist in the home or on the grounds

● **Four Kids Did Not Have a Physical in the File.**
