- 5 Important

Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were There Was Not a Gate at the Top of the Basement Stairwell. (1), A Sibling Group of Four Did Not Have an Enrollment Form in the File. (1), and On 11/19/2024 Upon Arrival 18 Kids of Mixed Ages Were Present in the Daycare with One Caregiver. The Provider Who Would Be the Second Caregiver Was Not Inside of the Home Upon Arrival. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

Jul 23, 2025 2 Findings ● 2 Important

- **A Sibling Group of Four Did Not Have an Enrollment Form in the File.**

Prior to acceptance of children, the caregiver shall have the parent or legal gu

- **There Was Not a Gate at the Top of the Basement Stairwell.**

The caregiver shall have stairways guarded by a gate or closed door.

Nov 19, 2024 2 Findings ● 2 Important

- **On 11/19/2024 Upon Arrival 18 Kids of Mixed Ages Were Present in the Daycare with One Caregiver. The Provider Who Would Be the Second Caregiver Was Not Inside of the Home Upon Arrival.**

The following child to staff ratios apply: Type of Home Child:Staff Ratio Infant

- **On 11/5/2024 20 Kids of Mixed Ages Were Present at the Daycare with Three Caregivers. Upon Arrival on 11/19/2024 18 Kids of Mixed Ages Were Present at the Daycare with One Caregiver. The Provider Who Would Be the Second Caregiver Was Not Inside of the Daycare Home Upon Arrival.**

The maximum capacity in a Class I child care home shall be twelve (12) children

Aug 1, 2024 1 Finding ● 1 Important

- **One New Caregiver That Was Present Did Not Have a Drug Screen on File.**

A child care home shall, at no expense to the state, maintain and make available
