Across 4 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Caregivers Did Not Follow the Infant's Individual Feeding Plan by Providing Them Breastmilk/formula That Wasn't Part of Their Scheduled Meal. (1), Caregivers Did Not Follow the Infant's Individual Feeding Plan by Providing Them Breastmilk/formula That Was Not Their Own. (1), and Toilets in Preschool 2 and Varsity Bathrooms Need to Be Sealed to the Floor. Cabinet Door in Varsity Bathroom Has Chipped Paint and Needs to Be Repaired. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
