Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Sippy Cups and Lids Were Stored Stacked Together in Kitchen and in Snack Tubs for Classrooms. (1), At Time of Visit Items Not Related to Toileting Were Stored in Bathroom as Follows: -Room B01 Had a Paper Bag Hanging; -Room B03 Had Toys, Broom, and a Plunger; -Room B04 Had Broom, Dustpan, and a Mop. (1), and Previously Opened Items Were Not Labeled with Open Date in Kitchen Freezers and Dry Food Storage Area. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
