The Toy and Child's Bib Were Removed While Consultant Present. (2), Two of Five Employee Files Reviewed Do Not Have Results of a Drug Screen on File. (1), and One of Four Files Reviewed for Staff Does Not Have Results of a Physical on File. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
