Across 1 inspection since 2023, the issues cited most often were Window in Playroom and Entryroom Covered with Plastic at Time of Visit. (1), Drug Test Results with MRO-Medical Review Officer Missing at Time of Visit. \*Send Documentation. (1), and Paint Cans on Basement Landing, Bleach in Basement, Dawn, Large Sanitizer, Bathroom Cleaner, Etc. Under Kitchen Sink and Hand Soap, Plumbing Cleaner Under Bathroom Sink Accessible to Children at Time of Visit. All Items State Keep Out of Reach of Children. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

A child care home shall, at no expense to the state, maintain and make available
- **Paint Cans on Basement Landing, Bleach in Basement, Dawn, Large Sanitizer, Bathroom Cleaner, Etc. Under Kitchen Sink and Hand Soap, Plumbing Cleaner Under Bathroom Sink Accessible to Children at Time of Visit. All Items State Keep Out of Reach of Children.**  
Caregiver shall keep poisonous or hazardous materials that would harm children,
- **Wood Panels/pieces, Wood Window Panels, Trash and Cardboard on Deck in Backyard at Time of Visit.**  
Caregiver shall not permit trash, flammable, and combustible materials, includin
- **Physical Missing for 1 Staff at Time of Visit. \*Send Documentation.**  
Direct child care providers who work in the home more than three (3) times a mon
- **Window in Playroom and Entryroom Covered with Plastic at Time of Visit.**  
Each room of the home where child care services are provided is required to have
