Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Thermometer in Sunfish Reading 54 Degrees with Milk and Cheese in Refrigerator. No Thermometer in Infant Refrigerator with Bottles of Milk Present. (1), Items Labeled Keep Out of Reach of Children Accessible: Infant/1 - First Aid Kit with Hand Cleaner Under One Sink, Garbage Disposal Cleaner Under Other Sink, Bluegills - Three Tubes of Lotion Under Unlocked Changing Table. (1), and Caregiver in Two's Room Using Time Out in Classroom as a Form of Behavior Motification. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
