Across 1 inspection since 2025, the issues cited most often were All Diaper Creams Need to Be Inaccessible to Children. The Toddler Room Had Diaper Creams in an Unlocked Diaper Changing Table. (2), One Staff Member Does Not Have First Aid Training. (1), and One Staff Member Does Not Have a Drug Screen on File. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **All Diaper Creams Need to Be Inaccessible to Children. The Toddler Room Had Diaper Creams in an Unlocked Diaper Changing Table.**

● **All Cleaning Supplies Need to Be Behind Lock and Key or Inaccessible to Children. The School-age and Infant Rooms Had Cleaning Supplies Accessible to the Children.**
